Patriotic Pride for Greenville County Project Overview

American Flags will be sold by the Rotary Club of Greenville to promote the continuation of and further the spirit of patriotism in our community that was demonstrated during the September 11th crisis.

- * Patriotic Pride for Greenville County is the goal and project name.
- * Proceeds from the project will guarantee an American flag in every classroom in Greenville County schools (currently 156 classrooms do not have flags). Proceeds from the sale of the flags will be used to educate children in every 3rd grade classroom about the flag, patriotism and the importance of flying our flag. A booklet on the flag will be given to every 3rd grader (approximately 5,000). Additional funds raised may be used for scholarships.
- * Rotarians are asked to: (1) Purchase a minimum of 2 flags (2) Promote Patriotic Pride on their street – sell flags to your neighbors, make your street 100% Patriotic Pride.

Target is to have flag displayed in neighborhoods throughout Greenville County on six key patriotic holidays – Flag Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Armed Forces Day, September 11th and Veterans Day.

- * This is a TOP QUALITY FLAG
Flag specification: 3'x 5' nylon flag with sewn stripes and embroidered stars, 10' steel white powder-painted pole 1" in diameter (two 5' sections) with wood finial and an aluminum sleeve to be driven into the ground that can stay fixed to insert the flag for display.
- * Price \$25 for the full kit.
You can buy a cheaper flag in a local retail outlet but not the quality of this product and not for the benefit of promoting patriotism in our community and with our school children.
- * July 4, 2002 is the target date for the first display of the Patriotic Pride project in Greenville County
- * Display of the flag is to be approximately 6-8 feet from the street curb in the center of the yard to provide consistency for display of all flags throughout the community.
