Dear Rotarians,

A brief report on the status of our invitations to Presidential candidates:

Mitt Romney has accepted our invitation and is scheduled to speak to us at the October 23rd meeting. The former Governor of Massachusetts, Romney was the second highest GOP speaker choice of the club.

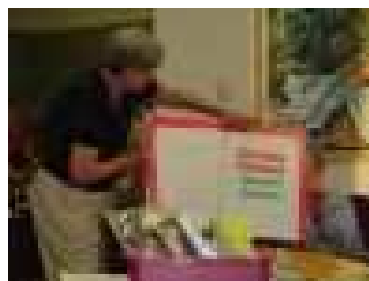
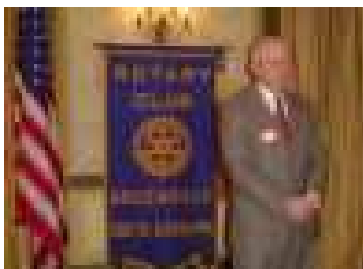
