Dean Moss is a recognized authority on interstate disputes which threaten South Carolina's access to water. He will address water issues from the SC perspective, such as the ongoing Southeastern drought, South Carolina's resources, Atlanta's problems and efforts to access the Savannah River, and the Catawba River dispute between the Carolinas.



Dean is General Manager of the Beaufort Jasper Water and Sewer Authority and has been in that position since 1986. Prior to that he had over ten years experience in water and wastewater planning and management at the state, regional and local levels in Florida, Arizona and North Carolina.

He has a BA in Geography from the University of Denver and a Masters in Regional Planning (Water Resources) from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

He is a U.S. Navy Veteran and served in Vietnam in 1968.

He has served as a member of the South Carolina Water Law Review Committee and as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Water Research Foundation. He currently serves as a member of the South Carolina Governor's Savannah River Committee and is the Governor's appointee to and Chairman of the Savannah River Maritime Commission.
