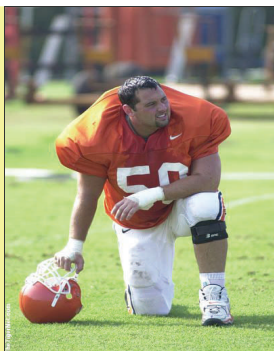

Will Merritt

Will Merritt was a three-year starter at Offensive Line on the Clemson University football team and a four year letterman.



Will was named All-ACC in 2000 and 2001, as well as being rated 15th best Offensive Guard in the country by two different national publications in 2001.

Will now hosts a syndicated sport talk radio show and is a weekly guest of ESPN radio and FOXSports radio.

Will is the co-owner of both Apex Development Group and Mulch Mart of Powdersville and is the football Color Commentator for the Clemson Tigers Sports Network.

George Rogers

Former University of South Carolina All-America running back George Rogers won the 1980 Heisman Trophy,



presented annually to the nation's top collegiate football player.

Rogers was selected first team on all the recognized All-American teams his senior year in 1980 when he led the NCAA Division 1A in rushing.

He was the first player chosen in the NFL draft and starred for the New Orleans Saints before moving on to the Washington Redskins. A native of Duluth, GA., Rogers rushed for a school-record 5204 yards during his four-year career (1977-80) at South Carolina. He gained more than 100 yards in each of his last 22 games, and in his 46-game career, he rushed for more than 100 yards 27 times.

Rogers was inducted into the University of South Carolina Hall of Fame in 1987.
